So for those who did not get a chance to give for the food pantry, here is your chance, or maybe some who gave for the food pantry would like to give for this too.

Like last year, a friend of our congregation has let us know that Trempealeau County Human Services needs pajamas of all sizes. They also could use diapers, cleaning supplies, detergent, and feminine products. These items would help moms or dads that are trying to get out of a tough situation. As for pajamas, you can donate new pajamas from ages 2-12 years old. (They could especially use ones for the older kids.) If you would like, then, bring your donation of either pajamas or the other items to church and put them in the bin by the coatroom. The deadline for this collection is Monday, December 16. This is a continuation of the Pajama Grandma program that a woman from Trempealeau County started years ago to make sure that foster children received at least one Christmas present, pajamas.
