#### <u>Important Items at Upcoming Voters' Meetings</u>

On May 18<sup>th</sup> we will be having our Spring Vision Together Meeting and on June 1<sup>st</sup> we will be having our Spring Voters' Meeting. We will be discussing and voting on the following important items:

- **New Playground:** We have been working on getting a new playground for our church and preschool. We'd like to share with the congregation the cost, what it will look like and get approval on how we will pay for this necessary item for our ministry.
- **Five Year Plan**: We've been working on developing a Five Year Plan for the last couple of years and will now share this with the congregation for review and approval.
- **Mission Enhancement Status**: Applying for Mission Enhancement Status is part of the Five Year Plan and thus we'd like to discuss this program with you in more detail and also get approval to begin planning for the application process.
- Increasing Size of the Council: After much discussion, the council would like to propose to expand the number of men who serve on the council. This will help us as we continue to grow our ministry and will also help with burnout.
- **Review and Approval of the 2025-2026 Budget**: As is normally done, we will review the proposed budget on May 18<sup>th</sup> and vote on the budget on June 1st.
- Voting for New Council Members: On June 1st, we will vote for new men to join the council.
